

How to use this document:

This document is ordered by Parliamentary Constituency, then by ward, then by existing polling district and polling place. Where changes are proposed, or views are sought, this will be detailed in the (Acting) Returning Officer comments. Some maps are available where changes are proposed, and these can be accessed via our consultation site.

Where there are changes proposed, or comments made, about a polling district, it is highlighted in red in the table.

New wards are due to be brought in for Westmorland and Furness for the May 2027 elections, but the old wards are still in existence. Some changes proposed are a consequence of new warding arrangements brought in by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, or by Westmorland and Furness Council at the Community Governance Review.

(Acting) Returning Officer's Comments:

Kirkoswald (Renwick) parish ward - EGN Renwick and EGO Scarrowmanwick – This is a parish ward with more than one register, so we propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called EGN. We would like to hear the views of local electors.

Currently using Renwick Reading Room, Renwick, Penrith, Cumbria, CA10 1JT as Methodist Schoolroom has been sold. The Reading Room is inadequate, due to poor access and facilities. The Chapel in the village is being developed and should be available as a better solution in the future. However, until that becomes available, we recommend that electors in Renwick vote instead at Kirkoswald Church Institute which is in the adjoining parish ward. We welcome any comments from local electors.

Kirkoswald (Renwick) EGO (Scarrowmanwick) register electors are currently voting at Croglin Reading room which is located across parish and W&F boundaries in Ainstable parish ward. We propose instead to send these electors to vote within their own parish at Kirkoswald Church Institute.

Langwathby Village Hall EGP and EGQ is due to begin renovations soon and will be unavailable for elections in May 2027. Langwathby Methodist Chapel has been visited and would be a suitable temporary alternative within the community until the Village Hall renovations have been completed. We welcome any comments from local electors.

(Acting) Returning Officer's Comments:
Castle Sowerby parish – EJA Millhouse and EJB Castle Sowerby – This is a parish with more than one register, so we propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called EJA. We would like to hear the views of local electors.
Newton Reigny Memorial Hall (EJC) has some access issues, and we are keen to hear from local electors if there are any other suitable alternatives.
Hesket Parish The number of wards in Hesket has been changed from 3 to 5 (each with 3 councillors). The 5 wards are Armathwaite, Calthwaite, Hesket (including High and Low Hesket), Plumpton and Southwaite.
All Saints Church, Calthwaite (EJI) does not have toilet facilities on site, but the other facilities and access are good. There are currently no other suitable alternatives within the community itself. Therefore, we recommend that we continue hiring a portable toilet for election days and designating All Saints Church as the Calthwaite polling place.
The Pot Place at Plumpton (EJJ) has been used as the polling station in Plumpton for some years now. While it is currently up for sale, it is being sold as a going concern and therefore should still be available for use in the future. We propose designating The Pot Place as the polling place for Plumpton.

Hesket (Southwaite) parish ward – EJK Ivegill and EJL Southwaite – This is a parish ward with more than one register, so we propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called EJL. We would like to hear the views of local electors.

Hesket (Southwaite) EJK register electors are currently voting at Ivegill Village Hall which is located across parish and Westmorland and Furness ward boundaries in Skelton parish ward. We propose instead to send EJK register voters to vote within their own parish at Low Hesket Village Hall. This is outside their parish ward though, and we would like to hear from local electors if there are any suitable alternatives within the ward itself.

Skelton (Laithes) and (Lamonby) parish wards – EJQ register (Laithes) and EJR register (Lamonby) are both currently being sent to vote in Skelton Memorial Hall which is in the parish area but is outside their wards. We would like to hear from local electors if there are any suitable alternatives within the wards themselves.

(Acting) Returning Officer's Comments:
Penrith (Carleton) EKA – the boundary between EKB and EKA has been altered as a consequence of the LGBCE review. As a result, a number of electors who previously voted at The Rooms, Penrith Parish Centre, St. Andrew's Place will now vote at Penrith Rugby Club. These include some of the properties on, and adjacent to, Barco Avenue, The Parklands, and Carleton Meadows. **The new boundary can be seen on this map, between the parish wards of East and Carleton:** <https://www.lgbce.org.uk/sites/default/files/2025-09/penrith.pdf>
Penrith (Pategill) EKC electors have been voting for several years at Penrith Rugby Club which is in the adjoining Parish Ward. We propose designating Penrith Rugby Club as the polling place for Penrith (Pategill) EKC electors now but would like to hear from local electors if there are any suitable alternatives within the polling district itself.
Penrith (Pategill) parish ward - The boundary for Penrith has now been amended so that the majority of properties currently located south of the A66 below Kemplay roundabout but north of the river are now part of Yanwath & Eamont Bridge Parish EMR register. This will also reflect a change of polling place, moving them instead to Eamont Bridge Village Hall. **Please see MAP A – Penrith and Yanwath & Eamont** which shows the area moving from ENB (Penrith South Rural) and EKC (Penrith Pategill) to EMR (Yanwath & Eamont Bridge).
Penrith (South) parish ward – ENA Penrith South and ENB Penrith South Rural – This is a parish ward with more than one register, so we propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called ENA. We would like to hear the views of local electors. The ENB electors going forwards will be part of Yanwath & Eamont Bridge parish (EMR) register because of the boundary changes in the Community Governance Review. The boundary for Penrith has now been amended so that the majority of properties currently located south of the A66 below Kemplay roundabout but north of the river are now part of Yanwath & Eamont Bridge Parish EMR register. This will also reflect a change of polling place, moving them instead to Eamont Bridge Village Hall. **Please see MAP A – Penrith and Yanwath & Eamont** which shows the area moving from ENB (Penrith South Rural) and EKC (Penrith Pategill) to EMR (Yanwath & Eamont Bridge).
Penrith (West) parish ward - ENC Penrith West Part I and END Penrith West Part II – This is a parish ward with more than one register, so we propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called ENC. We would like to hear the views of local electors.
Penrith West parish ward has two registers ENC – Pen West Part I 1496 electors and END – Pen West Part II 694 electors. There are two polling places used in this parish with a combined electorate of 2190. Penrith (West) END register electors have been voting at The Salvation Army which is in the adjoining Parish Ward. We propose sending all electors to just one polling place instead. The Salvation army is a very active hub, and elections often displace community groups using the venue. Castletown Community Centre is the larger of the two polling places and is located within the Penrith West ward itself: It would be a more suitable option if combining the polling places. We welcome any comments from local electors.

- The polling place for **SDH** is out of the polling district but is suitable and not too far to travel. We welcome views from electors in Torver as to any suitable alternatives.
- The polling place for **SDD** in Skelwith is no longer available to the Returning Officer. The (A)RO recommends moving the polling place to Brathay Church Hall, LA23 0HS. We would like to hear from voters in Skelwith if there are any alternative polling places.

(Acting) Returning Officer's Comments:

- Barton & Pooley Bridge and Dacre

The boundary between these two parishes has been amended slightly, moving a small number of properties from Dacre parish EMD register into Barton & Pooley Bridge parish EHD register, which also reflects a change in polling places going forwards for those properties. However, no current registered electors have been affected.

Clifton Primary School has now been designated as the polling place in Clifton. The Village Hall has been closed and sold and is no longer available, and St Cuthberts church was deemed unsuitable. There was a proposal at our last polling district review that electors be sent to vote at Lowther Village Hall instead, but an appeal was upheld against that decision and therefore Clifton Primary School is currently designated. We welcome views from electors in Clifton on using the school or any other suitable alternatives in the polling district.

(Acting) Returning Officer's Comments:

- **SAA and SCK:** There has been a minor change in the boundary between the parishes of Allithwaite & Cartmel, and Lower Holker. We are altering the polling district boundary to match, which will mean a small number of properties all situated on Lakeland Leisure Park will move into SCK, resulting in a change of polling place. **Please see Map D – Allithwaite & Cartmel and Lower Holker.**
- **SBA1, SBA2 and SBA3:** At a recent Community Governance Review, the parish wards of Grange Parish will be abolished by order. The Electoral Commission guidance states that a parish area should be a polling district, unless there are special circumstances. Due to the size of the Grange Parish area, it is still desirable to split the polling district, but we do intend to split it into two polling districts. To achieve this, I propose that we merge SBA2 and SBA3 into one polling district, called SBA2.
- Both SBA1 and the proposed new polling district of SBA2 have the United Reformed Church Hall as their polling place. This venue is one of the busiest in the authority and is not ideal for parking. We welcome views from voters in Grange as to whether the United Reformed Church Hall is still suitable, or whether any alternative venues could be considered.

Hutton parish – EHG Motherby and EHH Hutton – This is a parish with more than one register, so we propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called EHG. We would like to hear the views of local electors.

Matterdale Parish has two registers EHL – Matterdale and EHO – Watermillock. We propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called EHO. We would like to hear the views of local electors.

Matterdale Parish There are two polling stations used in this parish with a combined electorate of 351 (EHL – Matterdale 192 electors and EHO – Watermillock 159 electors). We propose combining these into a single register and then sending all electors to just one polling place instead. Matterdale Church meeting room is quite a small venue so Watermillock Village Hall would be a more suitable option. We welcome any comments from local electors.

Mungrisdale parish – EJM Mungrisdale and EJN Mungrisdale North – This is a parish with more than one register, so we propose to merge these into one single register, which will be called EJM. We would like to hear the views of local electors.

Barton & Pooley Bridge and Dacre

The boundary between these two parishes has been amended slightly, moving a small number of properties from Dacre parish EMD register into Barton & Pooley Bridge parish EHD register, which also reflects a change in polling places going forwards for those properties. However, no current registered electors have been affected.

Dacre Parish is a large non-warded parish with 4 separate registers and using 4 separate polling places; EMD – Dacre 64 electors, EME - Great Blencowe 38 electors, EMF – Newbiggin 303 electors and EMG – Stainton 600 electors. It is divided by the A66, separating EME and EMF from EMD and EMG. We propose combining these 4 registers into just two registers. EME and EMF will merge to become one polling district called EMF. EMD and EMG will merge to become one polling district called EMG. We then propose to close two of these polling places (Blencowe Village Hall and Dacre Village Hall), sending the two smaller stations to their larger neighbouring stations instead. We propose that EME Blencowe electors instead go to Newbiggin Village Hall and EMD Dacre electors go to Stainton Village Hall instead. Both of those polling places are nearby and large enough to accommodate the increased electorate. We welcome any comments from local electors.

- The boundaries of **SBM** have changed significantly. We propose two new polling districts called SBM1 and SBM2 that will split the new Heron Hill parish ward, which contain elements from SBM, SBS, SBQ and SBT1. SBM1 includes areas around The Lound, Archers Meadow and other properties on the south side of Parkside Road, plus some streets on the Heron Hill estate. - There are a number of changes in Ulverston arising from changes to parish warding arrangements brought in by the LGBCE. All these proposals should be read in conjunction with the map at this link: <https://www.lgbce.org.uk/sites/default/files/2025-09/ulverston.pdf>
- **SUC and SUI:** Arrangements in SUC and SUI have resulted in altered parish warding arrangements in Ulverston, moving some properties previously in SUC into the SUI polling district. This will also reflect a change in polling place for affected properties.
- **SUH:** the polling place for SUH is Croftlands Community Centre. This is in the neighbouring polling district of SUC. There are no suitable alternatives identified within SUH, and the identified polling place is very close to the boundary of this polling district, but we welcome suggestions from electors in that area for alternative venues.
- **SUI:** the polling place for SUI is The Coronation Hall, Ulverston. Whilst this is a prominent and well-used local building, it is often unavailable on election day due to other events taking place. In recent years, St. Mary of Furness Catholic Church Hall has been used and is a suitable alternative. We welcome views from local electors.
- **SUJ:** The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has altered parish warding arrangements in Ulverston, creating two new wards in SUJ. To administer elections effectively, we need to split the polling district SUJ into two new polling districts. These will be called SUJ and SUK. SUJ is the West ward, and SUK is the South West ward.
- **SUJ:** The new polling district of SUJ has St. Mary's R.C. School as its designated polling place. This is a suitable venue, though we have had comments at previous reviews about the inconvenience of closing a school. We are not aware of any other suitable venues within the revised polling district of SUJ. We welcome suggestions from voters as to alternative venues.
- **SUK:** The new polling district of SUK has no designated polling place yet. Electors in this area previously went to St. Mary's R.C. School, however now that is outside of the polling district. We are not aware of any suitable venue within the polling district that can be designated as a polling place. We propose that electors in SUK go to Croftlands Community Centre as it is close to many of the properties in the new polling district. Views are sought from electors in the new area of SUK as to where the most convenient venue would be, or whether there are any alternative venues.
